(As per the standard terms of the contract a 50% deposit is required at time of signing this contract with the balance due five days prior to the event date.)

Standard Terms of Video Production Contract

This constitutes an order to produce a DVD from raw video footage provided by the client upon receipt of deposit.

Photographic/Videographic materials: All photographic materials, including but not limited to negatives, digital images, magnetic or optical media and transparencies, produced as a result of this project shall remain the exclusive property of Digital Production Studios for exclusive use by the Client.

Ownership of copyright: It is understood that the raw footage provided by the client is the property of the client and no other, and is protected by the client's copyright of such material. Digital Production Studios will not knowingly produce a DVD that infringes on the copyright of another. If a question of copyright ownership arises, it is up to the Client to provide proof of copyright ownership.

Copyright and Reproduction: Federal copyright law gives professional photographers/videographers the exclusive right to control the making of copies of their photographs or video content. Violators of this law are subject to both civil and criminal penalties. Digital Production Studios and its affiliates shall own the copyright for all projects created and shall have the exclusive right to make reproductions. Digital Production Studios and its affiliates shall only make reproductions for the Client or its portfolio, website, samples, promotions, entry in photographic contests or art exhibitions, editorial and promotional use, or for display. If Digital Production Studios desires to make other uses, Digital Production Studios shall not do so without first obtaining the written permission of the Client.

Booking: Upon signature and receipt of deposit, Digital Production Studios will reserve the time required to accomplish this project. For this reason, all deposits are non-refundable; if date is changed and sufficient notice is given, the deposit will carry forward to the new date. If the project is canceled for any reason, the deposit is forfeited. Full value of the project is earned 48 hours prior to the start of work on the project. Notice to cancel must be given prior to 48 hours. Even if project is canceled prior to 48 hours deposit is still forfeited. If the Client fails to provide material for the project or fails to cancel within 48 hours of the project start all charges are considered earned and the Client will be held responsible for payment. Cancellation prior to 48 hours must occur through speaking or writing directly to a representative of Digital Production Studios.

Military: We support and want to extend our appreciation to all military personnel. If orders are changed requiring a change in the project date all deposits will be forwarded. We ask that notification be given to Digital Production Studios as soon as possible.

Failure to Perform: Digital Production Studios guarantees to work on your project according to the terms of this contract. If Digital Production Studios cannot perform this Agreement due to a fire, strike, act of God, war, traffic conditions, road conditions or other unforeseen tragedy, Digital Production Studios shall return the deposit to the Client but shall have no further liability with respect to the Agreement.

Inherent Qualities: Client is aware that color dyes in photography may fade or discolor overtime due to the inherent qualities of dyes, and the Client releases Digital Production Studios and its affiliates from any claims whatsoever based upon fading or discoloration due to such inherent qualities. Client is further aware that improper use or storage of DVDs and other optical or magnetic media may also cause fading, distortion, loss of audio or video signal over time and the Client releases Digital Production Studios and its affiliates from any claims whatsoever based on optical or magnetic media degradation due to such inherent qualities.

Digital Production Studios Standard Price List: The charges in this agreement are based on Digital Production Studios' Standard Price List. This price list is adjusted periodically and future orders shall be charged at the prices in effect at the time when the order is placed. Payment: Magic Video Project packages require a deposit of ½ the total order due at signing of this contract. Balance due five days prior to session date. Payments can be made by cash, money order, or certified check. A certified check is one prepared by the bank, made out to Digital Production Studios. Our on-line Payment page can accept payments made through PayPal by credit cards and e-checks. Please be aware that e-checks take from 3 to 4 business days to clear the bank processing. Any fees incurred in reference to collecting payment due to “Digital Production Studios” will be the responsibility of the Contracting Party (the Client).
